He founded the organization in 1999, together with

educational travel professional Katherine Rice DeFreitas. Between them, they have made over 40 trips to Cuba forging friendships, gaining knowledge, and building relationships that provide the foundation for all the trips we arrange.

We have worked closely with a broad range of organizations including MassHumanities, Oxfam, the Nieman Foundation at Harvard University, and the Eastern Massachusetts Senior Softball Association.



We maintain close working relationships in Cuba with many fine non-governmental institutions including the Ludwig Foundation for the Arts, the renown company Danza Contemporanea de Cuba, the National Chorus of Cuba, the Patronato Synagogue and Caritas Cubanas. We have highly reliable contacts at the Cuban government travel organization Havanatur for hotels and other travel services.

Our groups are regularly briefed by Senior Officials from the US Interest Section in Havana. Lectures and superior guides make sure that each trip offers a genuine learning experience. Meetings with artists,



academics, and authors add depth that make each traveler's experience richer and more personal.
